NEW TRAIN FROM HUBLI TO VARANASI AND MYSORE TO BELGAUM

1712. SHRI SHIVKUMAR UDASI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a demand to extend NZM-Vacso Goa Express to Mangalore as daily train and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government would consider the long pending demand to start a new train from Hubli to Varanasi via Miraj, Manmad, Bhopal, Delhi and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government would consider to start intercity train from Mysore to Belgaum, Hubli to Udupi via Madgaon and Mysore to Madgaon via Davangere, Hubli in Karnataka and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) A large number of representations are received at various levels of railway administrations which inter alia include Railway Stations, Division, Zonal Headquarters and at Railway Board level. However, Indian Railways do not maintain compendiums of such representation.
- (b) & (c) At present, there is no proposal to introduce new trains from Hubballi to Varanasi via Miraj, Manmad, Bhopal and Delhi; Mysuru to Belgaum (Belagavi); Hubballi to Udupi via Madgaon; and Mysuru to Madgaon via Davangere and Hubballi, due to operational and resource constraints.
