**(a)&(b) The following projects have been sanctioned by Railways to reduce imports bills and pursue "Make in India" initiative of Indian Railways:**

**(i) Setting up of a traction alternator manufacturing factory for high horse power Diesel Locomotives at Vidisha: Under present sanction, the factory will be set up through Government funding.**

**(ii) Setting up of a Forged wheel factory: This work will be done by Rashtriya Ispat Nigam Limited (RINL) at Raebareli at their own cost.**
