- (a) the extent regulations governing the ownership of a private aircraft in the country;
- (b) whether the Government has any proposal to change the regulation regarding owning a private aircraft in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;

- (e) whether the number of private aircraft ownership has increased during the last five years; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof, State/UT wise?

- (a): As per Civil Aviation Requirement (CAR) Section 3 Series C Part XI para 3.1.3 for import of private aircraft, a recommendation will be made to Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) by Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) for grant of import license, after ensuring that the aircraft meets the airworthiness and age related requirements and after receipt of security clearance of its Owner/Director from MHA.
 - (b) & (c): DGCA has no proposal to change the regulation regarding owning a private aircraft in the country.
 - (d): 106 numbers of private aircraft owned by individuals or companies in the country at present.
 - (e) Yes, Madam.
 - (f) The details are attached Annex-I.
