(a)to(d):Infrastructure projects in Major Ports are reviewed on regular basis at various levels in the Government. List of Projects in Major Ports which are awaiting final approval for implementation is given below.

Port Projects which are idle

Sl. No.	Name of the Port	Name of the Project	Action taken by the Port/Government
1	Kamarajar Port	Iron Ore Terminal	The Project has been restructured and RFQ issued. Two Bids have been received at RFQ stage
2.	Kandla Port	Project of Development, Operation, Management and Maintenance of Berths No. 11 and 12 in Kandla Port as Container Terminal on Build, Operate and Transfer (BOT) basis for a period of 30 years	The Project has been restructured and bids were invited. Two Bids were received from qualified bidders.

Requests have been received to complete these projects and adequate steps are being taken to complete them.
