- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a)&(b) Yes Madam. MCEPL has submitted 8 nos of claims for compensation/extension in concession period to NHAI. The detail of the claims is annexed.
- (c)&(d) NHAI has rejected all the claims of MCEPL except claim No.3 & claim No.7 which are under adjudication before Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court.

4	4	Rs. 49 crore on account of incurring expenditure on account of various activities.
5	5	Rs 3 crore for maintenance of the project service road and site drain.
6	6	Rs. 27 crore on account of pending liabilities obligations of erstwhile concessionaire.
7	7	Rs 0.26 crore on account of removal of toll boom.
