- (a) the details of the profits and losses of public and private airlines operators during the last three years, airline-wise and year-wise;
- (b) whether only a few airports are making profits and many of the airports in the country are running in losses;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the remedial measures being taken by the Government in this regard and to explore non-aeronautical income opportunity of the airports?

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- (a): The details of the profits and losses of public and private airlines operators during the last years, airlines-wise and year-wise are attached as Annexure-I.
- (b) and (c):- Details of profits making airports and loss making airports owned by Airports Authority of India (AAI) are given in Annexure-II and III.
- (d): Airports Authority of India (AAI) envisages to introduce some new services like airport concessionaire for Food and Beverages, retail services, etc. to provide better services to the passengers and increase non-aeronautical revenue. AAI intends to develop the city side for commercial exploitation to increase the non-aeronautical revenue. AAI has also undertaken the exercise of tapping the cargo potential at such airports.
