Will the Minister of LAW AND JUSTICE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the print editions of the "Constitution of India" as published by the Legislative Department of the Ministry of Law and Justice generally remain in short supply *vis-a-vis* public demand;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the remedial steps taken/being taken by the Government in this regard so as to ensure adequate availability thereof?
