- **(b) & (c):** The functioning of NGOs are reviewed from time to time. The NGOs which were found to be violating the norm/guidelines of the scheme are either asked to refund the amount released dto them alongwith panel interest or are blacklisted and no further grants are released to them under any scheme of the Government for promotion and development of handicrafts.
- (d): The field officers of Government have been instructed to personally inspect the activities sanctioned to the NGOs and ensure that the said activities are being organized as per the norms/guideline of the scheme.
