(a) As per available information, no ship carrying weapons has entered into Indian waters from Sri Lanka. However, a vessel MV Seaman Guard Ohio (Flag Sierra Leone) carrying arms and ammunition was interdicted by Indian Coast Guard within our territorial waters and escorted to Tuticorin Port on 12th October 2013 and handed over to local police. An FIR was registered by Marine Police Station, Tharuvaikulam against crew / security guards present on board.
