**NEO-NATAL SURGERY AT AIIMS**

**2082. SHRI SULTAN AHMED:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of new born admission at Neo-natal surgical ICU at All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi during each of the last three years;
- (b) the number of reported deaths and percentage in this group at Neo-natal surgical ICU, at AIIMS during the said period; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to reduce the number of reported deaths?

(a) to (b): The details of admissions and deaths in the Intensive Care Unit of the children surgical ward at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi (AIIMS) are as under :

Year	Admissions	Deaths	Percentage
2013	168	49	29.17%
2014	209	33	15.79%
2015	184	40	21.74%

(c): A large number of critical/ serious patients with multiple co-morbidities get admitted in AIIMS, New Delhi for their treatment. AIIMS has made Tuesday as a full time O.T. day for the department of Paediatric Surgery which was earlier upto 2 P.M. only on that day. A new Mother and Child Block with the provision of four regular OTs for Day Care Surgery is also being constructed.

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
