(a) & (b): The Committee headed by Dr. P. Rama Rao recommended demerger of Mysore based laboratory of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) i.e. Defence Food Research Laboratory (DFRL), with Central Food Technological Research Institute (CFTRI), a laboratory functioning under Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR).

(c) & (d): It was decided by the Government in September 2010 to retain DFRL with DRDO for its effective functioning and better utilization for the benefit of the troops.
