Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Women Protection Centres for providing safety and security to women have been established in the country and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the measures taken for monitoring women in these protection centres;
- (c) whether cases of sexual exploitation or harassment in women protection centres have been reported during the last three years and the current year; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise along with the action taken thereon?

- (a) to (d) No Madam. However, the Ministry is administering the scheme of One Stop Centre for Women implemented through States/UTs from 1st April 2015 for facilitating/providing medical aid, police assistance, legal counselling/court case management, psycho-social counselling and temporary shelter to women affected by violence. The funds have been sanctioned/released to 31 States/UTs for establishment of One Stop Centre. Till date 6 One Stop Centre are operational in Raipur (Chhattisgarh), Vijayawada City (Andhra Pradesh), Karnal(Haryana), Bhubaneswar (Odisha), Jaipur (Rajasthan) and Chandigarh.
