Will the Minister of **FINANCE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that a number of vacancies are lying vacant in the Income Tax Department;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

- (a) to (c): Cadre Re-Structuring in Income Tax Department was approved in 2013 and 20,751 additional posts have been created in various cadres with effect from 23.05.2013. For filling up of vacant posts, promotions are done on regular basis as per the Government instructions and prescribed procedure, which is an ongoing process. For filling up of the vacant posts by method of direct recruitment, vacancies are regularly reported to UPSC and SSC.
