Setting up of IIMs

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has set up new Indian Institute of Managements (IIMs) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the criteria for admission in the said IIMs?

- (a) and (b): During 2015, six Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) have been set up at Amritsar (Punjab), Bodhgaya (Bihar), Nagpur (Maharashtra), Sambalpur (Odisha), Sirmaur (Himachal Pradesh), and Vishakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh). The classes of these IIMs have commenced from the academic session 2015-16 from their temporary campuses.
- (c): IIMs follow uniform eligibility criteria in Common Admission Test (CAT). Admission to various IIMs is made through admission policies developed by the individual IIM and CAT scores are used as one of the inputs in the admission process. Other inputs inter alia include marks in class 10, class 12 and graduation and work experience.
