CARRYING CAPACITY AND SITE SPECIFIC STUDY

2413. SHRI RAJESH RANJAN:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that carrying capacity studies and site specific studies have been/are being undertaken in the tourism industry;
- (b) if so, the purpose of the study; and
- (c) the process being followed/to be followed for undertaking these studies?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a): Yes, Madam. Ministry of Tourism (MOT) undertakes carrying capacity/site specific studies as and when required. Recently, MOT has undertaken a study on tourism carrying capacity of existing and potential destinations in Uttarakhand.
- (b): The objectives of such studies are to assess the carrying capacity of the destinations, assessing the gap in tourism infrastructure, identification of promotional needs of the destinations, etc.
- (c): MOT conducts studies through consultancy firms/organizations. Selection of consultancy firms/organizations is done by following the General Financial Rules of the Government.
