Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Government is running tool rooms and technology development centres for providing technological assistance to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;

(c) whether there is no technology development centre in Haryana and if so, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the steps taken by the Government for opening at least three technology development centres in Haryana?

(a)&(b): Government of India in Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises runs 10 tool rooms and 8 technology development centres to provide technological and skilled manpower support to the industries particularly MSMEs. The details of tool rooms and technology development centres State-wise are given below:

(I) Tool Rooms (10 nos.)

(c)&(d): At present, there is no Tool Room / Technology Development Centre run by Ministry of MSME in Haryana. However, Ministry of MSME have been implementing Technology Centre Systems Programme (TCSP) under which 15 new Technology Centres (Tool Rooms and Technology Development Centres) are to be established in the country and the existing Technology Centres are to be upgraded. On the request of State Government of Haryana, one Technology Centre at Rohtak and its Extension Centre at Saha (Ambala) have been approved under TCSP, to be implemented over a period of 6 years.
