- (a), (b) & (c): An Indian Resource Panel (InRP) has been launched on 17.11.2015 with an objective to develop an action plan to promote utilisation of secondary resources thereby contributing to sustainable development. The functions include recommendations regarding appropriate policy and legislative framework for achieving resource efficiency.
- (d): The Panel is to submit its report to the Government within two years.
