Emission of Green House Gases

2603. SHRI C.S. PUTTA RAJU:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FORESTS AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any study has been made to find out the extent of emission of green house gases due to the use of domestic refrigerators and air conditioners and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the likely trend in this regard during the next five years; and
- (c) the efforts being made to ensure use of energy efficient appliances to get both savings on power bills and less emission of green house gases?
