Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FORESTS AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the pollution caused by indiscriminate use of fertilizers and pesticides has affected the fishery resources in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof State-wise including Kuttanadu in Kerala;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to tackle this issue; and
- (d) whether the Government has conducted any impact study on the wetland ecosystem of Kuttanadu and if so, the details thereof?
