Referred to in part (d) and (e) in the reply to the Unstarred Question No.261 for answer in Lok Sabha on 1-12-2015, raised by Shri Laxmi Narayan Yadav and Shri Chandra Kant Khaire, MPs, regarding "Financial Assistance to NGOs".

Planning Commission authorized the Mott Mac Donald, Noida, Uttar Pradesh to conduct the evaluation study in respect of Scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/fitting of Aids/Appliances (ADIP) in May, 2011. Mott Mac Donald submitted the final Report in December. 2012. The major findings of the issues pertained to weak Institutional coordination, poor and untimely release of funds, lack of proper and updated database of differently abled people on the census record, lack of maintenance cost of assisted devices, lack of system to evaluate the work done by Implementing Agencies, lack of awareness among the beneficiaries about the scheme. The Scheme was revised w.e.f. 1st April, 2014. Issues raised in the Evaluation Study were duly considered during revision of the ADIP scheme.

Another NGO based study was conducted by the Ministry during 2013-14 on Construction of Hostels for Other Backward Classes (Boys and Girls) in the States of Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat. The following recommendations were made:

- > A detailed need-based assessment should be carried out for selection of districts before forwarding the proposal for construction of Hostels and the process completed within a stipulated time-frame.
- Adequate number of new hostels should be constructed in the adjoining areas of metro cities including Noida, Ghaziabad, Lucknow, Bhopal and Ahmedabad.
- The active involvement of Panchayati Raj Institutions / Urban Local Bodies should be ensured during pre-construction and post construction period.
- All hostels should be refurbished as per indicative norms outlined in the current scheme guidelines.
- > Design for hostels should have provisions for ramps for barrier free movement of physically handicapped students.
- > There should be uniformity in terms of rules and regulations for Boarding and Lodging across States. The criteria for allotment should be uniform.
- > Security must be provided in girls hostels. Clean hygienic toilets, bathrooms and hostel premises must be provided.
