NMSH objectives are being achieved under the various programmes /schemes of the Government including Swachh Bharat Mission, Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), Smart Cities Mission and National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY).
