Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT & ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal for setting up advanced training institutes at various places in the country under crafts instructor training scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof for each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (c) whether it is being implemented on pilot basis;
- (d) if so, the details of locations identified for setting up of these institutions in first phase and the criteria adopted for selection of these places;
- (e) the details of shortcomings being faced by such existing training institutes at present;
- (f) the steps taken to improve the existing training institutes till they are not replaced by advanced ones?

(a) & (b) Yes Madam, the Government has received proposals from the State of Andhra Pradesh and Punjab.

(c) & (d) Government is setting up ATIs in PPP mode under the scheme of "Enhancing the capacity of Training of Trainers". In 1st phase following 12 states have been identified:

The States which have identified the locations for the setting of these ATIs, has been taken in the 1st phase.

(e)&(f) The training capacity in existing institutes at present is limited as compared to actual requirement. Thus, infrastructure capacity of these institutes is being enhanced for additional trades and units.
