EXTENSION OF NZM-VASCO GOA EXPRESS

2776. SHRI PRATHAP SIMHA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a continuous demand to extend NZM-Vasco Goa Express to Davangere as daily train and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government would consider the long pending demand to start a new train from Hubli to Varanasi via Miraj, Bhopal and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government would consider to start Intercity train from Mysore to Belgaum via Arasikere and Mysore to Madgaon via Davangere in Karnataka; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) A large number of representations for introduction of trains and extension of existing trains are received at various levels of Railway administrations which, inter-alia, include Railway Stations, Division, Zonal Headquarters and at Railway Board level. However, Indian Railways do not maintain compendiums of such representations.
- (b) to (d) At present, there is no proposal to introduce new trains from Hubballi to Varanasi via Miraj, Bhopal; Mysuru to Belagavi (Belgaum) via Ariskere; and, Mysore to Madgaon via Davangere due to operational and resource constraints.
