**EXPANSION AND RE-DEVELOPMENT OF STATIONS**

**2804. KUMARI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE:**

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

**(a) whether the Railways is considering to make expansion of platform at Udupi railway station and laying of a pit line for maintenance of engine and coaches at the same station and if so, the details thereof;**

**(b) whether the Railways is also considering upgradation of Kundapur and Surathkal railway stations and if so, the details thereof;**

**(c) whether expansion plans of Mulki railway station is under process and if so, the details thereof; and**

**(d) whether the Railways proposes to expand and re-develop Murdeshwar railway station falling in between Karwar and Udupi and if so, the details thereof?**

**ANSWER**

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS**

**(SHRI MANOJ SINHA)**

**(a): Yes, Madam. The work of widening of Platform No.1 from 6 metres to 12 metres for a length of 580 metres at Udupi Station has been taken up. At present, there is no plan for laying of a pit line for maintenance of engine and coaches at Udupi station.**

**(b): At Kundapur station, improvement of surface of approach road to Railway Station, modular shelters and concrete benches have been already provided in recent past.**

**At Surathkal railway station, parking area development work and provision of bio-toilets have been taken on hand. Modular shelter and concrete benches have been already provided in recent past.**

**(c): Yes, Madam. At Mulki railway station, work of Modular shelters has been taken up.**

**(d): Yes, Madam. At Murdeshwar railway station, development work includes provision of bio-toilets and additional modular shelters.**
