VILLUPURAM-DINDIGUL PROJECT

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Villupuram-Dindigul, a 273 km double track railway project has been delayed for four years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for delay;
- (c) whether any time line has been fixed to complete this proposed project;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of budget allocated for the project?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a) to (e) Villupuram-Dindigul doubling with electrification (273 kms) was included in Railway Budget 2008-09 and track linking in 253 kms length has already been completed. Out of this completed length, 90 kms section has been commissioned. An allotment of ₹ 520 cr. has been made for this project in 2015-16, against ₹ 265 cr. allocated in 2014-15 and ₹ 286 cr. allocated in 2013-14.

Due to delay in handing over of land by Government of Tamil Nadu, no target has been fixed for completion of doubling of the balance section.
