- c) whether besides permitting 100 percent foreign investment in real estate projects the Government also plans to make such investment tax-free; and
- d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a)&(b): As per extant FDI policy, FDI upto 100% under automatic route is permitted in Construction Development of Townships, Housing and Built-up Infrastructure, which inter-alia includes development of townships and construction of residential/commercial premises, subject to certain conditions.
- (c)&(d): There is no proposal at this stage for making such investment tax free.
