# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) & (b): The objective of the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) is universal coverage of water supply and sewerage connections, provision of public transport and non-motorized transport and developing greenery and open spaces. The objective of the HRIDAY is to develop and augment civic infrastructure facilities around heritage assets along with development and promotion of tangible economic activities to enhance avenues of livelihoods amongst residents/ stakeholders. As the AMRUT Mission and the HRIDAY have recently been launched, their effect on GDP can only be assessed after the approved projects are implemented.
