 - (i) Advised National Payment Corporation of India (NPCI) to develop and manage indigenously the ecosystem for Clearing and Settlement, Key Management, Simulating Cards, Terminals & Network, a support base of vendors for providing certified tools, cards, terminals and other services etc.
 - (ii) Taken decision that certification and authentication mechanism has to be developed by a Government agency or NPCI.
 - (iii) Circulated the business model of Kochi Metro Rail

 Ltd. (KMRL) for Common Mobility Card to all metro

 rail companies to explore the possibility of adopting
 the same at regional level.
