LAUNCH OF NEW SCHEMES

No. 2917 SHRI GOPAL SHETTY:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has started any new schemes for housing and urban poverty alleviation in the last one year;
- (b) if so, the details of the new schemes implemented/initiated in the last one year; and
- (c) the achievements and the main features thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING & URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

- (a) to (c): In pursuance of the Government's vision of facilitating housing to all by 2022, the Government has launched "Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)-Housing for All (HFA) (Urban)" Mission on 25.6.2015. The Mission aims to provide assistance to States/UTs in addressing the housing requirement of the slum dwellers and urban poor through following four verticals:
 - (i) "In situ" Slum Redevelopment through private participation using land as resource;
 - (ii) Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS);
 - (iii) Affordable Housing in Partnership; and
 - (iv) Subsidy for beneficiary-led individual house construction or enhancement.

As on date, 1183 Cities have been selected in 23 States under the Mission. Till now, 174 projects for construction of 2,30,403 houses of Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category in 98 cities of 6 States have been approved "in principle" under the Mission.
