Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has given any serious thought on compulsory exchange between the academicians serving in the universities and scientific/technical institutions and the professionals working at various levels in the respective Government, Semi-Government, Non- Government and private sector to derive benefits of academics into the profession and *vice-versa* and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has constituted a high-level Expert Group to delve upon this serious issue; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?
