ATMS AT RAILWAY STATIONS

2941. SHRI RAMSINH RATHWA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of ATMs of banks working at present at railway stations in the country;
- (b) whether there is any proposal to install more ATMs at Railway stations;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to publish a list of stations having ATMs on the Railway's website for the information of general public; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a): At present, 1287 number of ATMs are available at railway stations.
- (b) & (c): Installation of ATMs at a station is determined by the demand made by the banks and for assessing the same Zonal Railways have been authorised to invite tenders from the Nationalized banks interested in establishing the ATMs at the stations from time to time.
- (d) & (e): While there is no specific proposal at present, some Zonal Railways are, in fact, already displaying the list of stations having ATMs on their respective official websites.
