THEFT CASES

295. DR. A. SAMPATH:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a number of cases of theft have been reported in the residences of Members of Parliament in the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof indicating the total number of such cases registered during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any inquiry in this regard;
- (d) if so, the details and the outcome thereof during the said period; and
- (e) the corrective steps taken by the Government to stop such cases in future?

Delhi Police is making all efforts to improve security in the area. The steps/measures taken to crub such incidents are as under:-

- i. Pickets are deployed at strategic locations in MPs' residential areas to keep close watch on strangers/suspicious persons.
- ii. All the MPs' residential areas are being patrolled by the PCRs, Motor Cycles, beat staff and Gypsies.
- iii. CPWD authorities have been requested to install all necessary security gadgets in the MPs' residential areas.
- iv. All SDPOs & SHOs/New Delhi District have been directed to keep watch over the strangers and to conduct character and antecedent verification of servants in the MPs' areas on regular basis.
- V. In addition to the existing deployment at pickets, foot-patrolling, motor cycle patrolling, 30 additional police personnel have been deployed w.e.f. 13.03.2015 for dedicated deployment in the MPs residential area.

Two (02) new full-fledged Police Stations in South Avenue and North Avenue have also been set up especially for MP's residences in the North & South Avenue.
