creation of a 'Rashtriya Rail Sanraksha Kosh (RRSK) amounting to 1,10,237 Crores, consisting of Executive Director/Civil Engineering (Planning), Railway Board as Convener and Executive Directors of Finance Expenditure-I, Signal (Development), Electrical Energy Management, Mechanical Engineering (Project), Directorates of Railway Board as Members.
