(a) & (b) Yes, Madam. Ministry of Railways have approached various Charitable Institutions/ Social Organisations inviting them to be a partner with Indian Railways by adopting a few of the major stations nearby their area and associate in any suitable form convenient to them, with Indian Railways, including a periodical 'Shramdan' exercise with participation of volunteers from their institution as a part of the special intensive cleaning drives in the stations.
