SOLANKI AND SHRI RAJESHBHAI CHUDASAMA TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 16.12.2015 REGARDING INCREASING FREQUENCY OF TRAINS RUNNING TO/FROM GUJARAT

(a) & (b) Representations, *inter-alia*, for increase in frequency of trains are received at various levels of Railway administration, a compendium of which is not maintained. However, increase in frequency of existing services serving the State of Gujarat is not feasible at present, due to operational and resource constraints.

(c) to (e) At present, Dakor, Palitana, Somnath and Junagadh stations are adequately served by following services:

Name of station	No. of Mail/Express trains	No. of MEMU/ Passenger trains
Dakor	Nil	7 pairs (daily)
Palitana	01 pair of weekly service	4 pairs (daily)
Somnath	4 pairs of services, which include 2 pairs of daily service, 1 pair of service operating on five days of the week and 1 pair of bi-weekly service.	3 pairs (daily)
Junagadh	7 pairs of services, which include 3 pairs of daily, 1 pair of service operating on five days of the week, 1 pair of bi-weekly service and 2 pairs of weekly service.	(daily) and 2 pairs on MG line

Presently, there is no direct train service to Ambaji, as it is not on the railhead. However, pilgrims desirous of visiting Ambaji can avail trains going towards and having stoppage at Abu Road, which is approximately 20 Kms. from Ambaji.
