Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to enhance the budget of National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) for the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to amend the constitution of NSDC;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the details of works done by NSDC since its inception in terms of number of youths trained, year-wise and skill-wise in States and UTs including Karnataka?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

- (a) & (b) No, Madam. National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) is the implementing agency for skill development schemes of various Ministries/Departments like Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Udaan, National Urban Livelihood Mission. Under PMKVY, there is a budget of Rs. 1000 crore for the current financial year i.e. 2015-16. The funds under PMKVY are to be utilized through NSDC which is the implementing agency for the scheme. There is no proposal to enhance the budget provision under PMKVY during this financial year.
- (c) & (d) No, Madam. There is no proposal to amend the constitution of NSDC.
- (e) The NSDC has approved 39 industry led bodies called Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) to promote industry/employer participation out of which 29 SSCs are operational in various sectors like Agriculture, Automotive, Healthcare, Construction and Plumbing. Various kinds of training is imparted by NSDC for skill development across the Country. State-wise break-up of skill development training by NSDC for the period from 2011-12 to 2015-16 (upto 30.11.2015) is attached at **Annexure.**
