No. 2969. SHRI DINESH TRIVEDI:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to implement a system of cutoff dates wherein only those residing in a slum before a certain date will be eligible for free or concessional housing and if so, the details thereof:
- (b) whether the Government has received objections from any quarters about this policy; and
- (c) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING & URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

- (a): In pursuance of the Government's vision of facilitating housing to all by 2022, the Government has launched "Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)-Housing for All (HFA) (Urban)" Mission on 25.6.2015. The Mission aims to provide assistance to States/UTs in addressing the housing requirement of the slum dwellers and urban poor through following four verticals:
 - (i) "In situ" Slum Redevelopment through private participation using land as resource;
 - (ii) Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS);
 - (iii) Affordable Housing in Partnership; and
 - (iv) Subsidy for beneficiary-led individual house construction or enhancement.

Under the 1st component of the Mission, the Guidelines stipulates that eligibility of the slum dwellers like cut off date etc. will be decided by States/UTs preferably through legislation.
