The check-in facility for both domestic and international passengers of Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi is already available at the two metro stations namely, New Delhi Railway station and the Shivaji Park station. The check in facility in terms of equipment and connectivity have been provided by the airport operator i.e M/s Delhi International Airport Private Limited (DIAL) and the check in functions are performed by the Airlines or their representatives.
