**Nirmal Gram Status to Villages**

**3043. SHRI P.R. SUNDARAM:**

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of villages which have been transformed into Nirmal Grams during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of targets fixed for transforming villages into Nirmal Grams during the current financial year, State/UTwise including Tamil Nadu; and
- (c) the funds earmarked for transforming villages into Nirmal Grams during the said period, State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu?

**ANSWER**

- (a) Number of Gram panchayats awarded Nirmal Gram Puraskar (NGP) during each of the last three years is at Annexure-1. Under the new Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) launched on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2014, Nirmal Gram Puraskar (NGP) has been closed.
- (b) State/UT-wise, number of Gram Panchayats identified for making Open Defecation Free during 2015-16 as per Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) prepared by the States/UTs is at Annexure-2.
- (c) Funds required for transforming Gram panchayats into Open Defecation Free are provided under the Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin). Since SBM(G) is a demand driven scheme, hence no State-wise allocations made. However, State/UT-wise, central funds released during the last three years and the current year is at Annexure-3.
