(a) to (c) : Government of Arunachal Pradesh had allotted the Siang Upper Stage-I project (6,000 MW) to NHPC and Siang Upper Stage-II project (3,750 MW) to NEEPCO for implementation. However, Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation has proposed the development of a single multipurpose storage project of around 10,000 MW capacity in Siang sub-basin in place of the two stage projects. The proposal is under examination by the Government.
