#### HYDRO DAM PROJECT ON SIANG RIVER

### 3049. DR. C. GOPALAKRISHNAN:

Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether 10,000 MW hydro-dam project is proposed to be constructed on the Siang River in Arunachal Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the fund allocated; and
- (c) the time by which the work on the project is likely to commence and the project made operational?

#### ANSWER

(SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a) to (c): Government of Arunachal Pradesh had allotted the Siang Upper Stage-I project (6,000 MW) to NHPC and Siang Upper Stage-II project (3,750 MW) to NEEPCO for implementation. However, Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation has proposed the development of a single multipurpose storage project of around 10,000 MW capacity in Siang sub-basin in place of the two stage projects. The proposal is under examination by the Government.
