(b) to (d): As regards to evaluation of sick and closedown clusters it is stated that no such specific instance has come to the notice of this office so far. However, a terminal evaluation Study of Ambedkar Hastshilp Vikas Yojna (AHVY) during the 11th Five Year Plan was conducted by the Govt. through M/s Centre for Research Planning and Action, New Delhi. The report of the study reveal that the AHVY Scheme has made notable progress in majority of the components under Social and Design & Technology Interventions. In Marketing Intervention also the progress is more or less satisfactory. The Scheme has benefited a large number of craftspersons by providing them regular employment and enhance thus income. There has also been improvement in artisans' skills and their productivity levels and that there is a definite sign of economic and social empowerment among the beneficiary craftspersons, more particularly the women artisans.
