(a) to (e) National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) is the implementation agency for development/upgradation of national highways under different phases of National Highways Development Project (NHDP). To improve its effectiveness, it was felt that NHAI could be made more autonomous. Therefore, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways had set up a committee. The committee has suggested different measures to be taken to transform NHAI as an advanced and competent institution for planning, management and execution of highway project.
