**Construction of Toilets**

**3159. SHRI RAJESH KUMAR DIWAKER:**  
**SHRI JOSE K. MANI:**

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

(a) the number of toilets constructed in the country during 2014-15 and the number of households covered, State/UT-wise;

(b) the number of toilets proposed to be constructed and households covered during 2015-16, State/UT-wise;

(c) the funds allocated and released for the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) and the projected expenditure for the next three years;

(d) the targets set and achievements made under SBM during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UTwise;

(e) whether the progress made in achieving the targets is satisfactory; and

(f) if not, the reasons therefor and the details of the problems being faced in the implementation of the SBM and the corrective steps being taken by the Government in this regard?

**ANSWER**

(a) - (b) Since Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) is demand driven scheme hence State-wise targets are not fixed. State/UT-wise, the number of Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) constructed and households covered during 2014-15 and 2015-16 under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) is at Annexure-1.

In respect of Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban), against a target of construction of 25 lakh individual household toilet, 5.91 lakh toilets have been constructed since 2.10.2014. Against a target of construction of 1 lakh community and public toilets seats upto March 2016, 28948 have been constructed. The State-wise details are at Annexure-2.

(c) Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), the total fund requirement is estimated to be around Rs. 1,34,386 crore. The Central allocation and utilization during the last year and the current year is as under:

In respect of Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban), the estimated cost of implementation of SBM(Urban) based on unit and per capita costs for its various components is Rs. 62009 crore. The Government of India share as per approved funding pattern amounts to Rs. 14623 Crore. As on date Rs. 1361.38 crore has been released to the States/UTs for various components under SBM(U).

(d) Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) has been launched from 2.10.2014 with a goal to achieve Swachh Bharat by 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2019. Since Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) is a demand driven scheme, State-wise targets are not set. The State/UT-wise number of Individual household latrines (IHHLs) constructed during the last 3 years and current year is as under National Bharat Abhiyaan NBA/SBM(G) is at Annexure-3. As regards urban, the SBM(urban) has been launched on 02.10.2014 only, and the progress made since launch has been mentioned in reply to (a) – (b) above.

(e) - (f) There is a spurt in the progress of rural sanitation since the launch of SBM(G). In the first year of launch (from 02.10.2014 to 02.10.2015), against an expected outcome of 60 lakh toilets, 88.71 lakh toilets have been constructed. The challenges faced in implementation of the programme are sustainability of outcomes, lack of appropriate skills and implementation capacities at the grass root level. In order to address these, the Swachh Bharat Mission is also laying more focus on behaviour change and usage of toilets. The focus on capacity building has been increased, since there is a need to improve skills, especially those pertaining to community processes and triggering for collective behaviour change. In order to expand these skills and train the key stakeholders, State level workshops involving all the key stakeholders such as Collectors, CEO, Zilla Panchayats, Chairmen Zilla Panchayats etc. are being held in different States. Regional workshops to cross-share learning amongst different States are also being held. The Government of India has also undertaken direct training of Collectors and more than 200 district Collectors from across India have been trained so far. The Centre-State coordination has been increased through increased visits to States, coordination meetings, and reviews. There is also a renewed focus on IEC and a 360 degree media campaign is being envisaged to further boost it. The social media – twitter (@swachbharat), Facebook (Swachh Bharat Mission) and WhatsApp/HIKE - are being extensively used for sharing innovative ideas and cross learning. A National Rapid Action and Learning Unit has been constituted to institutionalise learning from the field and provide quick feedback. The technology aspect is also being focussed and an expert committee under Dr R.A. Mashelkar has been constituted to examine new innovations; and exhibitions are organised to spread these technologies amongst the States and other stakeholders.
