- (a) whether the aged and old vehicles are proposed to be scrapped to reduce the pollution level and congestion on roads;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the criteria laid down for diesel and petrol variant vehicles by National Green Tribunal (NGT);
- (c) whether there is any proposal to give incentive to the owner of such vehicles; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which such provision is likely to be implemented?
