Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY** WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether a number of reserved posts of doctors and faculties are vacant in the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;

(c) whether instances of discrimination and violation of reservation norms in recruitment, appointment and promotion of doctors and faculties have been reported in AIIMS, New Delhi; and

(d) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government thereon?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

(b): Details of vacant Posts of Assistant Professor/Lecturer of Nursing/Sr. Resident/Junior Resident are as under:-

The posts of faculties and doctors are unfilled due to non-joining of selected candidates/ unsuitability/unavailability/resignations/retirements. Filling up of posts is a continuous process and various steps including special recruitment drives for filling up of reserved posts are undertaken.

(c) & (d): Representations alleging discrimination and violation of reservation in faculty selections are received from faculties as well as other forums. The same are examined in light of the extant rules/regulation/instructions/orders on the subject and action taken thereon.
