(a) to (c): Madam, the Ordnance Factories are provided requisite staff on the basis of their workload and production technology. The factories are asked for manpower requirement from time to time and supplemented with the required workforce in terms of their requirement. There are no technical and non-technical posts lying vacant in Ordnance Factories which is adversely affecting the products related to Defence Production. Adequate manpower is being sanctioned based on load position to cater to the needs of Defence Production. The process of filling up of vacant posts in Ordnance Factories is a continuous process. In line with manpower requirement Ordnance Factory Board (OFB) has already issued sanction for the recruitment of 4895 Industrial Employees for the year 2015-16 and in addition to this OFB has also recruited 1514 technical / non-technical personnel in the year 2015-16.
