(d) With the approval of Prime Minister an Expert Group was constituted for restructuring and strengthening of Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) under the Chairmanship of Shri B.K. Chaturvedi, Member, Planning Commission on 21st October, 2011. The action plan on the recommendations of the Expert Group was approved by Raksha Mantri on 17.4.2013.
