3380. SHRI DEEPENDER SINGH HOODA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of the AIIMS Phase-II project, initiated in 2009 in Jhajjar, Haryana with a proposed 710 bed strong National Cancer Center as well as an AIIMS-2 Outreach OPD;
- (b) the details on the funds allocated in the year 2014-15 as well as 2015-16 for continuing the project;
- (c) whether the Government has set any deadline for completion of the project and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government plans to open a Medical College at the AIIMS Phase-II campus and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): The Bhumi Pujan Ceremony of the National Cancer Institute Jhajjar was held on 12.12.2015. The civil works for construction of the Institute Block have commenced. An amount of Rs. 60 crores has been allocated for the project. Completion of the project is dependent on availability of funds and other factors.
