SMART POLICE STATIONS

345. SHRI KALIKESH N. SINGH DEO:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has allocated and released funds for the setting up of Smart Police Stations and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the cost of establishment of Smart Police Stations will be borne by the Union Government and if so, the details thereof along with the total cost of establishment of the same in urban, semiurban and rural areas;

(c) if not, the details of distribution of funds between Union and State Governments;

(d) whether the Government has received proposals from all State Governments for establishing the model Smart Police Stations and if so, the details thereof and the time fixed for establishing of the same; and

(e) whether the Government has invited the private sector to contribute to the establishment of Smart Police Stations and if so, the details thereof along with the number of proposals received till date and the criteria for selection of private players?

(a) to (c): No Central fund for setting up Smart Police Stations has been allocated. As per concept paper drafted by BPR&D, the estimated cost of establishing a new Smart/Modern Police Station for Metro City is Rs.7.30 crore, for City Rs.6.74 crore, for Semi-Urban area Rs.4.56 crore and for Rural area Rs.4.02 crore.
